

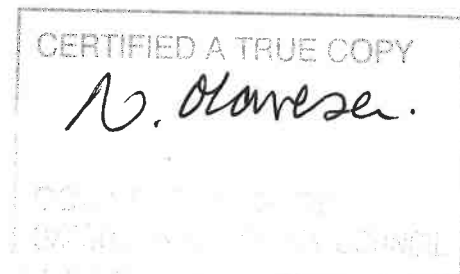
**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SHIPLAKE SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2016**

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Shiplake Speed Limits) Order 2016 and shall come into force on the 5th day of March 2016.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. The Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Shiplake Parish) Order 1999 and the Oxfordshire County Council (Shiplake) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 are revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20 miles per hour

a) Roads in Shiplake:

ROAD	FROM	TO
Memorial Avenue	from its junction with Plough Lane, north-eastwards	to a point 90 metres east of its junction with Orchard Close
Plough Lane	from its junction with A4155 Henley to Reading road, westwards	to a point 30 metres west of its junction with Memorial Avenue.
Orchard Close	for its entire length	
Plowden Way	for its entire length	

b) Roads in Lower Shiplake:

Road	From	To
Badgers Walk	for its entire length	
Baskerville Lane	for its entire length	
Brocks Way	for its entire length	
Crowsley Road	its junction with Station Road, southwards	its junction with Baskerville Lane
Lowes Close	for its entire length	
Mill Lane	from its junction with A4155 Henley to Reading road,	to a point 165 metres east of its junction with Mill Road
Mill Road	from its junction with Mill Lane	to its junction with Station Road.
Oaks Road	for its entire length	
Station Road	its junction with Lashbrook Road/Basmore Lane (east of the railway line), westwards	a point 75 metres west of Quarry Lane
The Chestnuts	for its entire length	
Westfield Crescent	for its entire length	

SCHEDULE 2

30 miles per hour

A4155 Henley to Reading road	from a point 650 metres north of its junction with Woodlands Road, southwards	to a point 342 metres south east of its junction with Plough Lane
Arch Hill	from its junction with Dunsden Way	to its junction with Common Lane.
Church Lane	from its junction with A4155 Henley to Reading road	to a point 230 metres southeast
Common Lane	from its junction with Sonning Common road	to its junction with Harpsden Road
Dunsden Way	from its junction with Shiplake Row	to its junction with Gravel Road in the parish of Eye and Dunsden
Emmer Green road	from its junction with Sonning Common road	to a point 200 metres southwest
Harpsden Road	from its junction with Sonning Common road	to a point 50 metres northeast of its junction with Common Lane
Memorial Avenue	from its junction with A4155 Henley to Reading road	to its junction with Plough Lane
Shiplake Row	from its junction with Memorial Avenue	to its junction with Dunsden Way
Sonning Common road	from its junction with Common Lane	to a point 298 metres northwest of its junction with Emmer Green road
Woodlands Road	from its junction with A4155 Henley to Reading road	to a point 1300 metres northwest and north (30 metres past the entrance to the property known as Summerhill Park), partly in the Parish of Harpsden.
